Knowing

Being

2. How does an individual become a member of this family (“brothers”) Paul is addressing in order to benefit from the blessed hope?
3. What difference will confidence in this blessed hope make in someone emotionally when he or she faces any suffering, but especially death?

Doing

1. If you have not committed your life to Jesus Christ and you have understood the truth of this passage, ask him right now to save you from your sins and give you the blessed hope of eternal life.
2. Think of someone you need to share this good news with in the next few weeks.
3. In view of Jesus imminent return, what are changes you need to make in your life so you may meet him unashamed?
