Main Theme: The Lord will provide for Himself a king for His people—namely, a champion who will fight and win on their behalf.

Author's Aim: to "exalt the horn of His anointed", I Sam. 2:10

David's God:

YHWH: LORD; covenant-making/keeping God

Present with His people

<u>Sovereign:</u> Supreme and independent power and authority. He directs all things in order to carry out his purposes (Rom. 8:28–29).
