Divine Deliverance in Desperate Days

I Samuel 21:10-15, Psalms 34 & 56

I. Desperate Days, I Sam. 21:10-15

II. Divine Deliverance, Psalms 34 & 56

Main Theme: God is worthy of worship because He always delivers His children.

I & II Samuel: Looking for a King

Psalms: Worshipping the King (a call for God's people to praise Him for Who He is, what He has done, and what He will do)



Three truths about God's deliverance:

- 1) it is always merciful and gracious
- 2) it is always according to the LOVING sovereignty of God
and His perfect will
- 3) it is always guaranteed—ultimately

Truth about God:

Isaiah 55:8-9

Deut. 29:29

Romans 11:33-36

Psalm 56-a Psalm of Lament

Lament Motif:

- 1) confront the crisis
- 2) conquer the crisis by:
 - a) naming it
 - b) praying to God to act
 - c) expressing trust in God

Shape/structure of lament psalms:

- a) Opening Cry to God, request for help, 1-2
- b) Declaration of confidence in God, 3-4
- c) Definition of the crisis, 5-7
- d) Declaration of confidence in God, 8-11
- e) Vow to praise God, 12-13

Psalm 34-a Psalm of Thanksgiving

(What God has done personally and in redemptive history)

- a) David's Personal Story, 1-10
- b) Instructions for God's People, 11-22
