and He can be trusted.

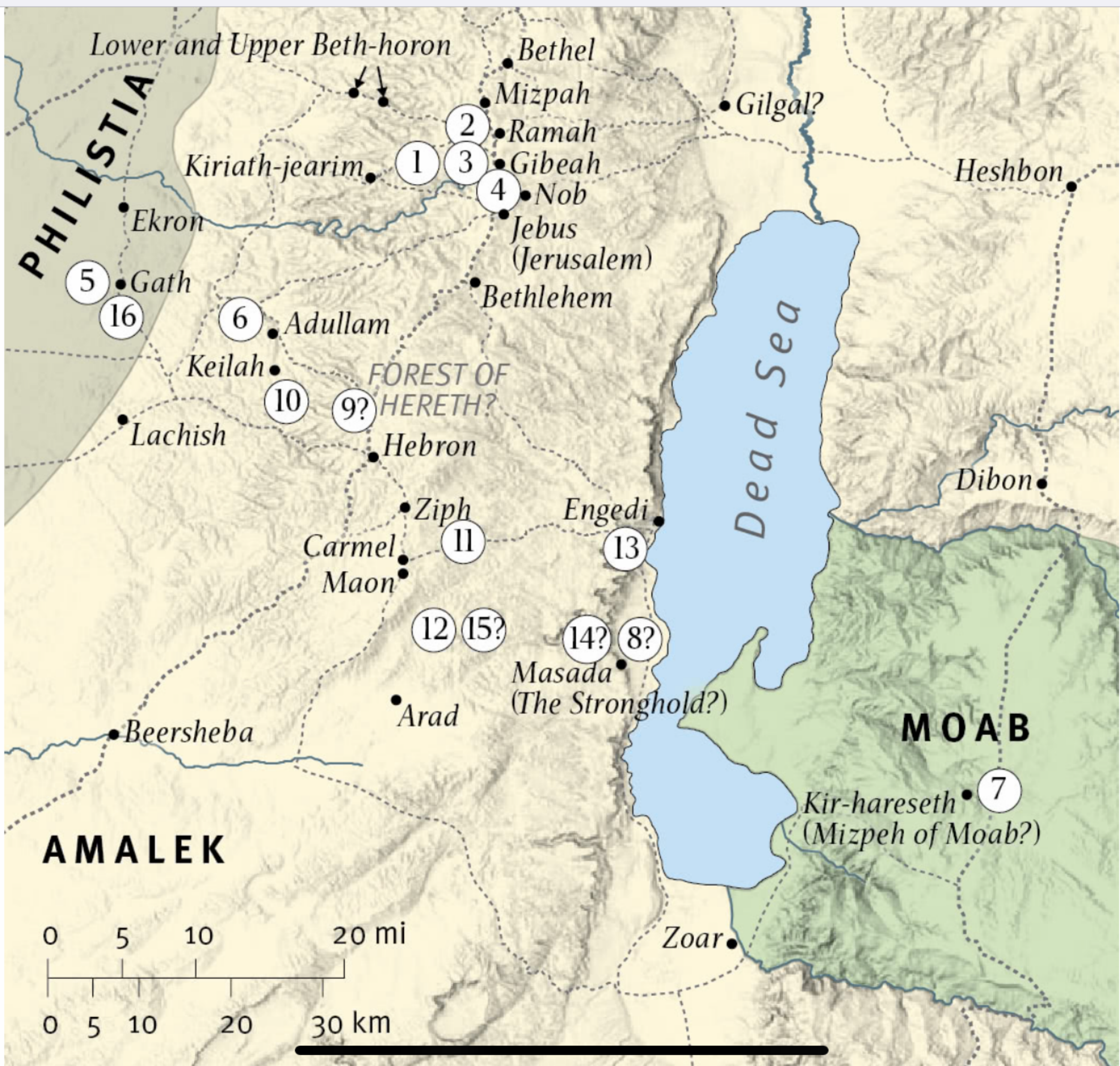
Divine Providence:
