Weekly Prayer Focus

World Missions–Randy and Martha: Since 2018, Randy and Martha have worked with EPC World Outreach training cross cultural workers. Ask God to guide them, giving them insight and wisdom as they coach and train key team leaders who are working in SE Asia. Pray for effective training and leadership through Zoom and other virtual vehicles. Ask the Lord to grant them discernment as they assess leaders and lead spiritual formation groups. Praise God for the "toolbox" they have developed to allow workers to thrive in spiritually and socially complex places. Pray that the Lord will allow them to travel again, resuming in-person training.

Domestic Missions–RedZone Ministries: RedZone Ministries serves urban youth in Orange Mound. RedZone praises God for His continued faithful provision for both their staff and the clients they serve. They express gratitude that during the winter months, they were able to provide food and shelter for hundreds of their homeless neighbors. Please pray for leadership at RedZone—for God to send them men and women who love and follow Jesus and who are compassionate and committed to His service.

2PC Ministry–Launch Program: Coordinated by Brett Wynne, the Launch program aims to train and send out new pastors for gospel ministry. Pastoral residents take seminary classes while receiving hands-on experience in all areas of pastoral work for up to five years. They are then "launched" into pastoral ministry—whether at Second or a different congregation. The Launch team praises God that He has used the program to send out many pastors to churches and church plants. Please pray for God to grant grace and margin to our current pastoral residents as they balance seminary and ministry duties. Pray also that God would continue to send pastoral residents to 2PC in order for more pastors to be trained and launched out.
