Scripture Introduction

1.Born in Love (v.7-8)

• "...whoever loves has been born of God and knows God."

2.Secured in Love (v.9-10)

• "...He loved us and sent His Son to be the propitiation for our sins."

3.Completed in Love (v.11-12)

• "...God abides in us, and His love is perfected in us."

4. Abiding through Love (v.13-16)

• "By this we know that we abide in Him and He in us, He has given us of His Spirit."

5.Empowered to Love (v.17-21)

• "There is no fear in love, but perfect love casts out fear...We love because He first loved us."

Discussion Questions

Knowing

- Why would we say that love has its origin in God? Can an unbeliever truly show love? How is the love shown by Christians going to be different?
- What is the difference between being compelled and controlled by God's love as opposed to just being inspired or motivated by God's love?

Being

- How does abiding in love give us confidence when we face the Day of Judgment? How would this give us assurance in our daily living?
- How does love cast out fear? What does fear reveal about our relationship with God?

Doing

- In what areas of your life do you feel it's difficult to show sacrificial love?
- Who are the people in your life that you find the most difficult to love? What steps do you need to make this week to change that?
