## Weekly Prayer Focus

**World Missions–Jamila:** Jamila is in the process of moving from Thailand, where she taught English to Chinese students, to the Middle East. She has joined an English Language Center there and agreed to teach for a two-year term. After visiting friends and family in the States, she will head back overseas at the end of this month. Praise the Lord for the many opportunities He is giving her to share His gospel grace! Pray for Jamila to remain sensitive and obedient to the Spirit through her travels and transitions, for smooth logistics and good humor as she re-enters the Middle East later this month, and for her to balance her listening and learning with a loving challenge to the gospel obstacles she encounters.

**Domestic Missions–A Way Out:** A Way Out (AWO) exists to disrupt the vicious cycle of sexual exploitation and trafficking by recognizing the innate value and dignity of all people; advocating for protections and legal justice for those trapped in the sex industry; helping restore the lives of victims; and raising awareness throughout the community. Their two-year Victim Assistance Program is one of the primary means by which they accomplish their mission. The ministry praises God for all the blessings He has given them through their many generous partners. Thanks to God's abundant provision, AWO can now serve even more women in need. Please pray for the women currently participating in their program—that God would grant them healing, transformation, and success. Pray also for wisdom for their staff.
