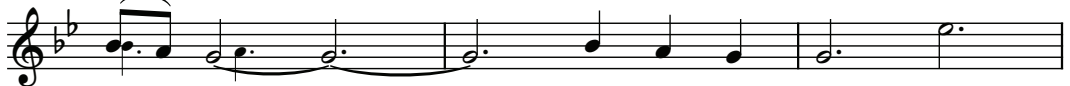

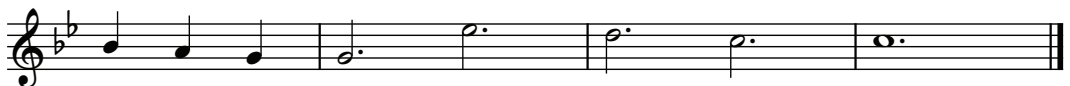

Weekly Prayer Focus

World Missions–Greg and Elizabeth: Greg and Elizabeth and big sister Hermione welcomed twins Naomi and Silas in February and have been adjusting to life as a family of five. They're thankful for the help they've received at home in Louisiana and while traveling this summer to visit relatives and attend General Assembly in Michigan and the Family Gathering in Greece. They plan to return to Beirut in early September and rejoin Nick and Amanda already there, serving Syrian refugees. Pray for their visas to be accepted and processed in a timely manner, for strength and grace as they travel with three little ones, and for their transition back into life and ministry in Beirut. Pray that their relationships with local friends pick up quickly from where they left off a year ago. The difficulties of living in Beirut are hard to imagine, yet they ask that the hope and joy of Christ be present and life-giving in all they do and say.

Domestic Missions–All Saints Presbyterian Church: All Saints Presbyterian Church exists to communicate the truth of the Gospel of Jesus Christ to the city of Memphis through the authenticity of changed lives, deep relationships, and committed service to those in need.
