



Weekly Prayer Focus

World Missions—Haley: Haley serves as a nurse at Annoor Sanitorium in Jordan. The hospital specializes in treating TB cases, while sharing the love of the great Healer himself. The more difficult the circumstances, the more miraculously the Lord shows up. Pray for the family of a long-term patient who recently died. They came from Sudan as the result of a dream and heard the Gospel clearly. The staff believes that they will come to Christ. Haley asks that God would bring relief to the many Bedouins who are suffering from addictions; pray the Lord would break the habitual behavior, heal the people, and show them that He is the One who has done it.

Domestic Missions—Binghampton Christian Academy: Binghampton Christian Academy is a private Christian day and boarding school that seeks to develop students both as scholars and godly leaders. They praise God that after a successful visit with the Association of Christian Schools International, BCA has been recommended for reaccreditation. Pray for the safety and health of both staff and students. Pray as well for wisdom as BCA's leadership team and board as they make plans for the 2022-23 school year.

2PC Ministry—Campus Outreach: Campus Outreach is a global network of ministries working through local churches to reach and develop the next generation of Christ-centered leaders on the university campus. Their mission is to glorify God by building laborers on the campus for the lost world. Since 1996, 2PC has served as the "hub church" of the CO Memphis region, which today consists of eight schools, two of which—Rhodes College and the University of Memphis—are local. As summer programs begin, please pray for CO staff and students—for those on Orlando Project, the 10-week discipleship and leadership program in Florida; for those in Lusaka, Zambia on a four-week Cross-Cultural Project and mission trip; and for those involved in 901 Summer Fellowship, a local Bible study for students in Memphis. Pray that students would dig deep into God's word, participate in biblical community, and readily share their faith.
