## Weekly Prayer Focus

**World Missions—John M.:** John M. serves in Southeast Asia, developing a sea cucumber hatchery as an inroad to plant churches. John thanks God for the recent dramatic growth in the hatchery and for the way that national church planters have integrated with the hatchery's Muslim employees and village partners. He is also grateful that he has been able to travel regularly to encourage his local partners. Pray that the Lord will continue to build up and bless the hatchery business and give it favor with providential officials who must approve its licensing. Pray also for open doors and open hearts as church planters share the gospel with hatchery employees and their families. Finally, pray for the development of a like-minded radio ministry that will reach thousands of SE Asia-islanders with the good news of the gospel.

**Domestic Missions—The Center:** The Center—Memphis is a faith and work ministry that exists to help leaders define reality and offer hope through the truth of God's Word applied to everyday life and work. They desire to see lives transformed as participants lead their families, organizations, and communities. The Center praises God that over the last year, their advisors had 200+ meetings with people seeking guidance in their careers. This resulted in 40+ people transitioning to new work or transforming their current work. Pray that the Holy Spirit will guide The Center's leadership small groups and transform the hearts, minds, and actions of all involved to be more like Christ (2 Cor. 3:18). Pray for God to enable entrepreneurs to create new jobs in Memphis where people can thrive in redemptive environments. Finally, pray that believers across Memphis will refuse to use image-bearers of God as a means to their own ends (whether professional, financial, or social) but instead embrace their role in the priesthood of all believers by leveraging their work and their resources to point others to Christ, joining Him as He makes all things new.

**2PC Ministry—Elders:** Elders at Second are nominated by the congregation and trained, examined, and approved by the Session before being elected by the congregation to oversee the spiritual welfare of the church. They do this by exemplifying Christ-like character, studying and teaching the Scriptures, praying and caring for members experiencing sickness or suffering, and stepping in to guide and warn members straying from the truth. As our elders reach out to our congregation, pray that God would grant them great joy as shepherds. Pray also for wisdom and encouragement as they begin shepherding members in their parishes.
