Weekly Prayer Focus

World Missions—Tim and Huilan: Tim and Huilan are regional leaders for their organization and train church leaders throughout East Asia. They are on a brief home assignment and have enjoyed re-engaging with supporting churches and friends. They were also able to attend the college graduation of their son, Ethan. They are very involved with a new field effort, the Center for House Church Theology, where Tim is a fellow and recently welcomed new team leaders. They raise up God's encouragement in Psalm 121:1-8 as they face uncertain times amid governmental changes. Pray for their family and for growth of their video platform ministries, which were not interrupted by new regulations over internet use.

Domestic Missions—My Cup of Tea: My Cup of Tea aims to walk with women beyond the boundaries of poverty and neglect to assist them in finding their purpose. My Cup of Tea employs women associated with the Orange Mound community in the packaging and selling of fine teas imported from the Far East. The ministry provides job security, resources for personal growth, outlets for social enterprises, daily Bible study guidance, and an oasis of deepening relationships among women of different zip codes and cultures. This Summer, My Cup of Tea added to their workforce two college students and one African refugee (who is associated with World Relief). They praise the Lord that the women of Orange Mound have embraced these new employees! Please pray that My Cup of Tea would be salt and light not only in Orange Mound but also to these new employees.

2PC Ministry—LAUNCH Program: Coordinated by Brett Wynne, the LAUNCH Program aims to train and send out new Christian workers (from pastors to counselors) for gospel ministry. Residents take graduate-level courses while receiving hands-on experience for up to five years in all aspects of ministry work relevant to their particular calling. They are then "launched" into their area of ministry—whether at Second or a different congregation or context. Pray for our residents as they take classes and do formal ministry full time. Pray that God would increase their capacity to read, study, write papers, and take tests. Pray as well that their studies would not be merely academic but would grow their love for Jesus.
