Weekly Focus on Missions

World Missions: Former Second members, Tezar and Tatiana, returned to his homeland to plant a church in Jakarta, Indonesia. After four years, Covenant City Church has nearly 350 weekly worshippers, is in the process of planting a Bahasa language church, and is encouraged by the growth of the community groups for this new church. Along with his responsibilities at CCC, Tezar mentors young pastors while Tatiana is engaged in counseling. The pandemic has caused all ministry to be done remotely as Jakarta returned to lockdown this month. Pray for Tezar, Tatiana, and their two young children to be aware of God's faithfulness during this stressful season. Pray also that the Holy Spirit would make the Gospel clear to those who God brings, so that many will come to know the Lord and that a network of collaborating churches will be formed.

Mission Memphis: Our partners at Su Casa Family Ministries are thankful for God's provision in the midst of very difficult circumstances for the families they serve. Many of the families have spoken of God being at work in their personal lives, work, and families. Pray that families would stay healthy and get back to work or be able to continue working. Pray also for rest for the staff and that the Lord would provide through their fundraising.
