Weekly Prayer Focus

World Missions–The Persecuted Church: Today we join Christians around the world in observing the International Day of Prayer for the Persecuted Church. When sisters and brothers who face all manner of suffering because of their belief in Christ are asked how we who worship freely can help them, their first response is, “Pray for us!” Please pray for Second’s partners who are actively being persecuted in China, Indonesia, Malaysia, Kazakhstan, Turkey, Iran, and a number of other countries. Pray for courage, strength, and protection for those imprisoned for their faith and for gracious witness to their persecutors. Pray also for assurance of God’s presence and provision for those who have lost homes, livelihoods, and family members. Pray that Christians in free nations will begin to understand “the fellowship of suffering” (*Philippians 3:10*) and choose to stand with and support our persecuted brothers and sisters.

Domestic Missions–Refugee Empowerment Program: REP walks alongside refugees and immigrants as they build new lives in Memphis. They strive to maintain an environment where all feel welcomed and respected and where indigenous leadership is prioritized and promoted. REP praises God that their community members are successfully passing their citizenship tests! Ask God to use their partnership with Slingshot Memphis to increase REP’s capacity and impact. Pray also for affordable housing for those REP serves, particularly in light of the recent dramatic increase in housing costs. Finally, pray for increased volunteer participation and engagement.

2PC Ministry–Parents Day Out: Directed by Sha Holliday, Parents Day Out at Second seeks to provide a secure, nurturing, and loving environment where children can develop socially, academically, and spiritually. Please pray for PDO staff, parents, and children to remain healthy throughout the rest of the Fall semester. Pray for God to empower teachers to love PDO children as Christ does. Pray for children at PDO to know and follow Christ from a young age.
