Weekly Prayer Focus

World Missions–Steve and Margaret: In 2021, Steve and Margaret, along with their three sons, moved from Memphis to Addis Abba, Ethiopia where Steve pastors International Evangelical Church, a church that ministers to diplomats and international workers as well as many local congregants. Pray for Steve to have insight and understanding as he preaches and serves this diverse congregation. The Winsteads praise God for the recent baptism of 19 adults and 15 baby dedications. They are also grateful for Downline Ministry and for the Intern Program that began this fall. Pray that the Lord will use both ministries to grow people in their faith and equip them for ministry. Pray for Steve and Margaret's sons, Samuel, Noah, Benjamin, and Daniel, to grow in grace and truth. Pray for peace and provision for the Ethiopian people amidst conflict and 42 percent inflation, and for the Lord to bring salvation to many.

Domestic Missions–Nathan Street Ministries: Nathan Street seeks transformation in the lives of God's people in Binghampton by fostering relationships, developing life skills, and giving hope with the unconditional love of Jesus Christ. At weekly Club Nathan meetings, they minister to kids through Bible lessons, songs, crafts, and games. They also offer tutoring, coaching, and discipleship. Pray for the hearts of the kids whom Nathan Street serves, particularly that they'd be open to the gospel. Pray also for all the volunteer leaders who give their time to impact kids—that God would give them wisdom, energy, and joy as they serve Him.
