Weekly Prayer Focus

World Missions—Steve and Margaret: In 2021, Steve and Margaret, along with their three sons, moved from Memphis to Addis Abba, Ethiopia where Steve pastors International Evangelical Church, a church that ministers to diplomats and international workers as well as many local congregants. Pray for Steve to have insight and understanding as he preaches and serves this diverse congregation. The Winsteads praise God for the recent baptism of 19 adults and 15 baby dedications. They are also grateful for Downline Ministry and for the Intern Program that began this fall. Pray that the Lord will use both ministries to grow people in their faith and equip them for ministry.
