## Weekly Prayer Focus

**World Missions–Larry Brown:** After a year-long furlough in Memphis, Larry Brown is now back at African Bible College doing what he loves—teaching. Pray for the students as there are many obstacles in day-to-day living that make it difficult for them to attend and/or pay tuition. Larry felt blessed and encouraged this past year by the love expressed to him by friends, relatives, and supporters in the wake of Dr. Paul Chinchén's sudden death. Pray that the ABC Board of Directors can once again appoint as president someone who has a track record for education and administration and is also a godly missions-minded person and leader. Pray also for Larry's son, Carey, as he adjusts to a new college—University of Tennessee at Martin.

**Domestic Missions–Christ Fellowship:** Christ Fellowship is a bilingual PCA church in Horn Lake, MS. They praise God that four Hispanic students recently professed faith and were baptized! Pray for these young believers to grow in their knowledge of and love for Christ. The church also praises God that their neighborhood outreach has been successful, resulting in more visitors. Pray for God to heal the wife of one of the church's deacons, who has been diagnosed with aggressive liver cancer. Pray also for God to bring the church a pastoral intern next year and to bless their plans to plant a church in Southaven.

Finally, pray for God to provide the caretaking, therapeutic, educational, and healthcare services necessary to meet the needs of our brothers and sisters with disabilities.
