Weekly Prayer Focus

World Missions–Roger and Abi: Roger and Abi lead a community arts team in Japan and serve the Lord with many church plants including their own, Grace City Church Tokyo. They praise Him for the ongoing recovery of their son from his traumatic head injury in December, for two neighbors putting their faith in Jesus at the funeral of a beloved church member, for their new team members, and for the good work accomplished during the summer Olympics. They ask prayer for Roger's father as he mourns the passing of his wife of 51 years. Pray also for joy and grace for their church as it struggles to recover from Covid and its effects.
