Weekly Prayer Focus

World Missions-Brian and Joanne: Thankfully, Brian and Joanne's church can meet in person again and worship on the Sabbath with Christians worldwide. They praise God for the number of new Christians and visitors at Covenant Hope Church. In September, Brian was encouraged by the All-India Pastors conference. Pray for the pastors to be encouraged in their work and for Brian's teaching seminar for West African pastors. There is concern about the prosperity gospel's influence—pray for discernment and the effectiveness of scripture and the gospel. Pray for God's anointing on the new interns from Zambia, India, and Nepal. Pray for "Susan" as she strives to love and witness to her Muslim family and yet live independently. Pray also for David, a church visitor, to trust Jesus. Pray for much fruit from Brian and Joanne's labor for the Lord in the Middle East.

Domestic Missions–Sanctuary Counseling Center: Sanctuary is a non-profit counseling center that provides affordable, high-quality counseling services to ministry workers and their families. Sanctuary praises God for their new intern, Shayla Murray, who previously served at 2PC in the Recreation Ministry. Pray for her to grow and learn during her time at Sanctuary. Pray also for clients at Sanctuary to experience healing and renewal, so that they can pour out to others in our city.

2PC Ministry–Campus Outreach: Campus Outreach is a global network of ministries working through local churches to reach and develop the next generation of Christ-centered leaders on the university campus. Their mission is to glorify God by building laborers on the campus for the lost world. CO praises God for moving in the lives of UofM and Rhodes students. Pray for a continued hunger to know God and make Him known. Pray for CO staff as they invite students to their annual New Year's Conference in Chattanooga. Ask God to prepare students' hearts and remove barriers that would prevent them from attending. Finally, pray for CO staff to walk intimately with God, enjoy fellowship with other believers, faithfully carry out their responsibilities, and become increasingly burdened for the lost people around them.
