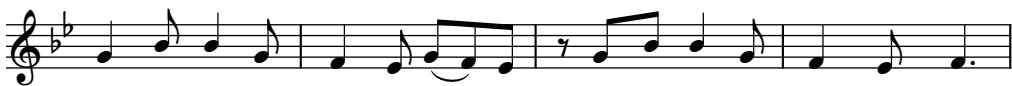

## Weekly Prayer Focus

**World Missions—Herb and Heather:** Herb and Heather request prayer as they wait to hear if their government will accept Annoor Sanitorium as a foreign-based nonprofit organization serving the people of their country. If the proposal they submitted is accepted, they can then request residency for their volunteers. More than 20 such volunteers are waiting for residency approvals, and the clinic's ongoing operation depends on these volunteers gaining legal residency. The Annoor Sanitorium has been treating the Bedouin people for tuberculosis for over 50 years with both an in-patient and out-patient clinics. They deeply sense the need for divine intervention with the government authorities. As they wait, pray for their ongoing work, that their patients find physical healing and spiritual encouragement through the gospel of Jesus.

**Domestic Missions—OMOM:** Orange Mound Outreach Ministries (OMOM) serves unchurched youth in Orange Mound, teaching them how to walk with Christ and live godly lives. They offer tutoring and homework help, Bible studies, small groups, movie nights, camping trips, and more. OMOM is grateful that all the kids they serve have safely returned to school. Please pray for the students' safety and spiritual growth throughout the year. Pray also for new volunteers.

**2PC Ministry—Grief Support:** Coordinated by Donna Sanders, GriefShare is an 11-week program that provides Biblical help, encouragement, and hope for the future to those who are grieving the death of a loved one. In addition to the 11-week program, a few times each year, 2PC hosts GriefShare workshops (such as a "Surviving the Holidays" seminar). Pray for the Fall session of GriefShare and the 30 people who are participating. Pray for participants to face grief rather than resist it, trusting God to walk them through the Valley of the Shadow. Pray that broken hearts will be mended as our gentle Shepherd carries them through this season.
