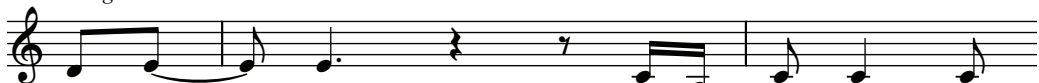

## Weekly Prayer Focus

**World Missions—Mike and Stephanie:** For many years, Mike and Stephanie have advanced the Kingdom of God as they love Muslims and proclaim the Lordship of Christ to them. Now, Mike travels throughout the world giving theological training to Muslim-born believers, and Stephanie assists him from their base in the States. Mike's book on spiritual formation, *In Quest of the Rock*, based on the life of Peter, has been recently published. Pray that this book will be well received and bless many in the areas of Christian growth and discipleship. Pray also that the Lord will bless and use Mike on two upcoming trips: training pastors in Sierra Leone and teaching the History of Christian-Muslim relations at a theological college in Ethiopia. Pray that the Lord will equip Stephanie as she ministers in World Outreach member care and assists Mike in his work.

**Domestic Missions—Multinational Memphis:** Multinational Memphis is a Christian organization that shows kindness to culturally diverse families—helping them to feel accepted, achieve academic success, understand our culture, and feel the love of God. Each year, more than 700 individuals from five continents and dozens of countries with many different languages, cultures, and religions come to Multinational Memphis for homework help, English classes, Bible stories, holiday events, Memphis experiences, and a chance to make friends. Pray for God to bless their Fall semester—strengthening their staff, providing more volunteers, and empowering them to effectively love those they serve.

**2PC Ministry—Music Ministry:** Led by Calvin Ellis, James Ryan, and Christy Young (with support from Ginny Atkinson), Second's Music Ministry exists to guide the congregation in joyful worship. The ministry blends many styles, genres, instruments, and choirs in order to reflect the growing diversity of our congregation and expand members' capacity to joyfully worship God in a variety of ways.
