Pray for Christians During Advent

Pray for the Reign of Jesus Christ to be Established in our City

⁶For to us a child is born, to us a son is given; and the government shall be upon his shoulder, and his name shall be called Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace. ⁷Of the increase of his government and of peace there will be no end, on the throne of David and over his kingdom, to establish it and to uphold it with justice and with righteousness from this time forth and forevermore. The zeal of the Lord of hosts will do this. *Isaiah 9:6-7*

- Pray for distressed neighborhoods to have a renewed sense of hope and anticipation of future opportunities that would contribute to communal flourishing.

- Pray for the sick to be healed and for those suffering to experience the comforting presence of Christ.
