- Weekly, Scripture-based study

1. Who can participate in this ministry?

Women who are members of Second Presbyterian Church. This program will match a mature discipler with a younger disciple.

2. What is the purpose of this ministry?

The goal is to provide an ongoing program for developing multi-generational discipleship relationships to facilitate spiritual growth for women at 2PC.

3. When does this program begin and when does it end? How frequently will you meet?

This program will run from September to April. It is intended that pairs meet weekly during those times, which is about 10 times in the Fall and 15 times in the Spring, on average.

4. Where will the discipleship meetings take place?

Discipler and disciple can choose the most convenient place to meet weekly. Some common places to meet are in homes, coffee shops, or at church.

5. What will the participants study?

There is a Scripture-based study/curriculum, *Come and See*, that is provided for participants.

6. How are discipler and disciple matched as a pair?

There is an online questionnaire for potential participants. The application includes both basic questions (marital status, work schedule, etc.) and relational/spiritual questions.
